**Kolesar & Leatham attorney appointed to Nevada State Advisory Committee
by U.S. Commission on Civil Rights**

LAS VEGAS – Matthew D. Saltzman, a shareholder at Kolesar & Leatham, a Las Vegas-based business law firm, has been appointed by the U.S. Commission on Civil Rights to its Nevada State Advisory Committee.

The U.S. Commission on Civil Rights investigates complaints of voter discrimination and denial of equal protection under the law due to race, color, religion, sex, age, disability, or national origin. It also reviews federal laws and policies with respect to discrimination and submits its findings and recommendation to the President and Congress.

The commission has an advisory committee in every state and the District of Columbia to assist with its fact-finding, investigative, and information dissemination functions. Members of the state advisory committee are specifically familiar with local and state civil rights issues, and they serve without compensation for a term of two years.

Saltzman received his bachelor's degree from the University of Wisconsin-Madison in 1987 and earned his law degree from the University of Pittsburgh School of Law in 1993.
